

GENERAL INFORMATION

Of the Larimer County Four Wheel Drive Club

- 1 Attendance ribbons for Perfect Attendance at meetings and on trips for the preceding year are given out at the January meeting.
- 2 Awards for Most Active Man, Most Active Woman, Most Active Couple, and the Boner Award are voted on at the December meeting and presented at the January meeting.
- 3 At the December Meeting, Santa arrives and presents each child with a gift provided by parents. The club usually provides goodies for children.
- 4 A sledding trip is usually held during the winter months for the kids.
- 5 On trips for “10-100’s” when no facilities are present - gentlemen to the left and ladies to the right.
- 6 A progressive dinner, potluck, or picnic is usually held at least once during the year.
- 7 Committees are appointed or volunteers solicited at the December meeting by the President.
- 8 The December board meeting is a joint meeting of the old and new boards, an is usually hosted by the out-going president,
- 9 Any member who has served 10 years of faithful service in the LC4WDC, is automatically considered a Honorary Board Member.
10. Unit numbers are assigned to members upon joining the club. If more than one family joins in a month, unit numbers are assigned in alphabetical order.
11. Dues must be paid by the March meeting in order to retain your unit number.
12. Members are to display their unit numbers on the front and rear of their vehicles,
13. Members no longer retaining membership may receive the newsletter for a cost of \$15.00 per year and will become associate Member.
14. The Ex-President will be an ex-officio member of the Board.
