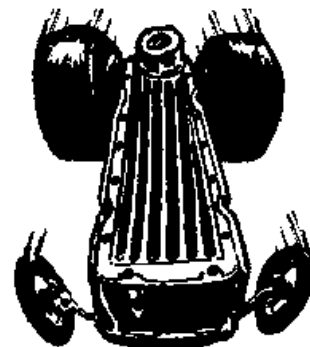
Valve Cover Racing Rules

The basic rules are as follows:

- 15” maximum width
- 30” maximum length
- 10” maximum height
- 10 lb. maximum weight
- No engines - No propulsion of any kind
- One valve cover per chassis - No switching chassis or cover
- Automotive valve covers only with stock gasket surface
- Nothing can be mounted in front of either the valve cover or chassis
- No moving or movable weight

The race will be for distance, exactly as last years.
